# EMERGENCY PLAN: WILDFIRE

Key information to prepare for fire events, poor air quality, and evacuation.

## FIRE AND AIR QUALITY

In the event of fire, reduce smoke inhalation by closing windows, wearing personal protective equipment, and running fans.



## EVACUATION

Check that evacuation routes remain accessible, and depart calmly if necessary. For California Highway Conditions, call 800-427-7623.



## EMERGENCY ALERTS

Sign-up for text alerts from Santa Barbara County in English or Spanish.
