

# EMERGENCY PLAN: HOSTILE INTRUDER

A step-by-step guide on what to do in the event of a hostile intruder.

## RUN

Be alert and determine if you can escape safely. If possible, the best course of action is to **GET OUT**.



## HIDE

If escape is not possible:

- **HIDE OUT:** Locate a room with locks, barricade the door, and stay quiet.
- **TAKE COVER:** Hide behind items that would deflect a bullet if necessary.



## FIGHT

**MAKE A PLAN**, and work with others to stay safe. While hiding, be active and prepare to fight an intruder if necessary. Locate items that could be used to protect yourselves.



## CONTACT POLICE

When possible, call 911. Inform the responder of your location and what danger you are in. When help arrives, **REMAIN CALM**, and follow instructions from the police.
