What is a mail order pharmacy?

Mail order pharmacies operate online. Licensed pharmacists will fill your prescriptions, answer any questions or concerns regarding your therapy or answer any of your health-related questions by phone, email or chat. Your medication is sent to you by a courier (such as Canada Post).

When should I purchase my medication through a mail order pharmacy?

If you take medication on a regular basis, ordering from a mail order pharmacy is a great option for you.

Typically, these pharmacies dispense 100 days-worth supply at a time. Prescription refills can be sent to you automatically, so you will never run out.

When you need to start treatment immediately, for example an antibiotic to treat an infection, it would be preferable for you to use a traditional pharmacy.
