

Supplemental Table 1. Providers' Attitudes Toward Caring For People with HCV

NOTE: The range of possible scores is 1-5. For compassion and willingness to treat, **lower scores** indicate greater compassion and greater willingness to provide care. For fears of contracting HCV and hostility toward PWID, **higher scores** indicate lower fear of contracting HCV and lower hostility toward people with HCV.
