The inherent contradiction of the most successful movies about wrestling (The Iron Claw and The Wrestler to name just two examples), is that they tend to be high-level productions that cast their sights on major awards contention, which puts them somewhat at odds with the real entertainment industry they attempt to represent. If we focus solely on the WWE, there's a hugely lucrative global business that never quite seems to dig itself out. It's only ever two steps away from a major scandal at worst, or a cringe-inducing creative decision, when the A24-produced, or Aronofsky-directed feature comes along. It all feels a little arms-length, as the spectacle it's tapping into.

Cuckoos are brood parasites that lay their eggs in the nests of other bird species and, once hatched, the chicks are raised by the unsuspecting host parents, who frequently reject their own eggs and young as a result. To Gretchen Hunter Schaefer, a teenage girl forced to move to the Bavarian Alps with her estranged father (Marton Csokas), his wife Jessica Heinwick, and their mute daughter Alma (Mila Liewal), after her mother's passing, the plight of the host chick must seem familiar. Alone in an unfamiliar place, neglected, and often outright ignored by her "new" parents, their other child, her cries for help are unheard or played down by those around her. For some people, the experience of being rejected by those who are supposed to love and care for you, who and what you are, is all too upsettingly familiar. The parasite may have infiltrated your nest, but species can be just as cruel.
