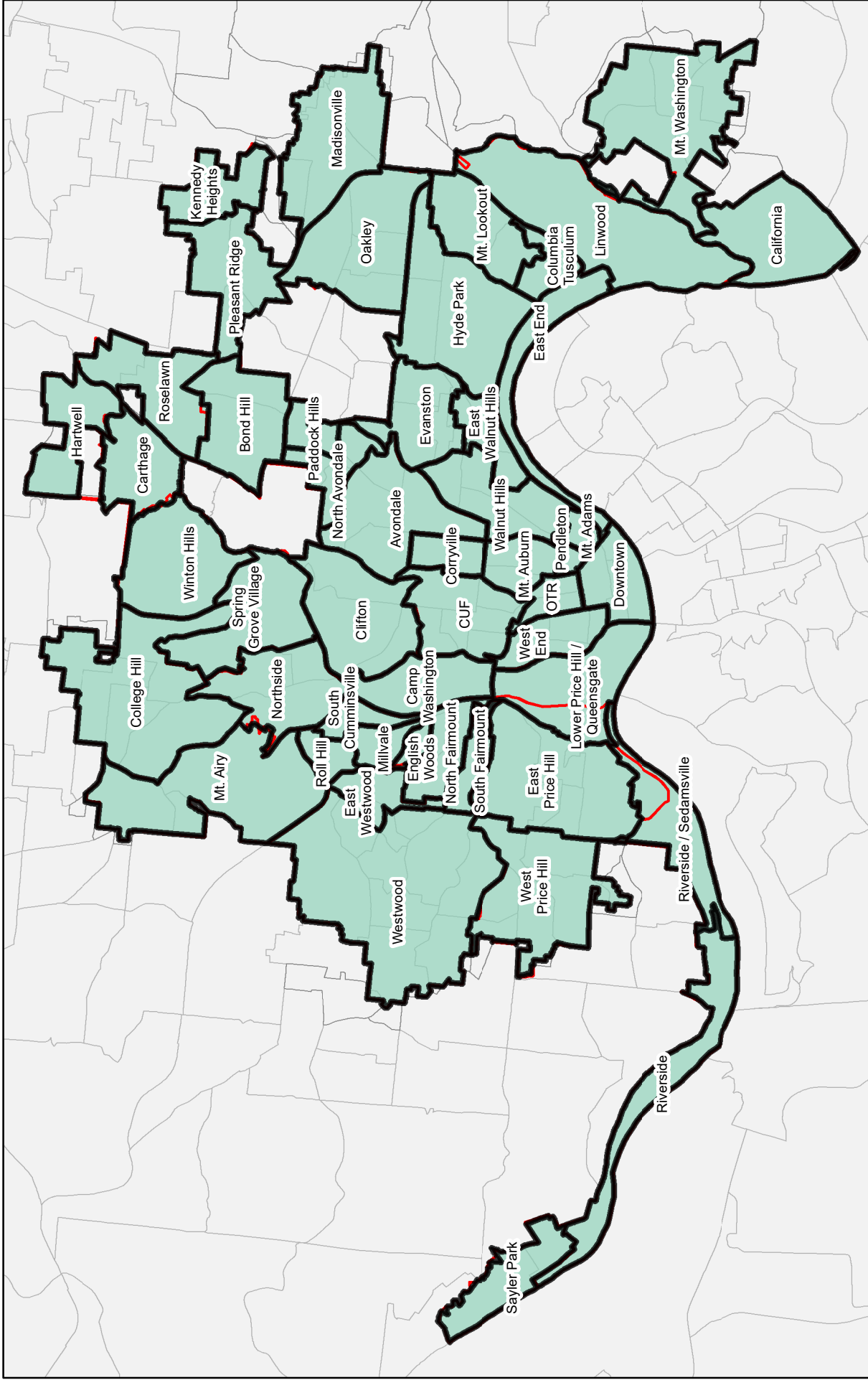
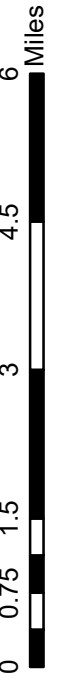


SNA Boundary Changes Citywide
